

About Eligibility:

This will be a part time certificate course open to all at junior as well as senior college level students. (Although preference will be given to the students having background of defense, psychology, NCC and to those who are pursuing career options in armed forces).

About Selection Process:

Students will be selected based on an entrance examination through the Non-Verbal Test of Intelligence.



About Duration and Mode of Learning:

The duration of the certificate program will be 3 months. There will be weekly 6 lectures of 1 hour each between 10.30 am to 11.30 am.

Being a part-time course, it will be practical based and will include virtual sessions, physical interactive sessions, group discussions, practical for assessment of psychological tools, field work, and projects related to the military psychology with case histories.
