

HOSTEL RULES

- It is mandatory for every Boarder to have a “Military Haircut”.
- Military training is mandatory for all the boarder students.
- Boarders should wake up at 5.00 am and be ready for the Flag Hoisting.
- Attendance for the Flag Retreat in the Parade Ground at 6.00 pm is compulsory.
- Attendance for Fall In at 8.00 pm in the hostel is compulsory.
- Every Boarder has to follow the various dress codes of the college.
- Boarder students are not allowed to enter the college premises or roam around the campus without proper uniform.
- Mess rules and timings should be followed strictly. Mess facility will not be extended beyond stipulated mess hours. Wastage of food should be avoided.
- Boarders are expected to stay in the room allotted to them by the authorities and should not mutually exchange under any circumstances whatsoever.
- Leaving the campus is not permitted. In emergency situations students can avail out-pass from Bhavan Master/RATO. Boarders- leaving the campus without out-pass will be dealt strictly.
- Boarders shall be responsible for the maintenance and cleanliness of their allotted rooms.
- The cleanliness of the verandah and the hostel premises is the responsibility of each boarder. Spitting and throwing litter in the premises will not be tolerated and offenders will have to face disciplinary action.
- Use of electrical appliances like iron box, heater, induction, AC, Cooler etc. is prohibited.
- Pets are not allowed in the hostel.
- Possession of weapons, explosives or inflammable materials is prohibited. Offenders will be punished and may be expelled from the hostel and college.
- Possession/Consumption of alcohol, drugs, tobacco and smoking is a serious offence and is prohibited. Strict disciplinary action shall be taken against the offenders.
- Ragging is considered as punishable offence. Students should abstain from committing ragging or such offences as no leniency will be shown to any student found guilty.
- After admission in the hostel, boarders will only be allowed to go home during Diwali vacation and summer vacation. In case of any emergency, leave may shall be granted by the Principal after completion of due procedure.
- Handling or using of others’ property without their due permission will attract strict disciplinary action.
- It is mandatory for the boarders to attend all the programmes and events organized by the college.
- Video shooting and clicking of photographs inside the hostel is prohibited.
- Celebrations of birthdays should be with prior permission of the Bhavan Masters. It should be done without any commotion or disturbance.
- Boys will not be permitted to enter into the girls’ hostel and vice-versa.

- Parents, relatives and friends will not be allowed entry beyond the designated area as it may lead to disturbance to others.
- Damage to the furniture/fixtures in the rooms or hostel premises will not be accepted and the concerned boarder will not only have to pay for the damages but will also have to face disciplinary action.
- Well defined layout of the furniture is to be maintained throughout the year and should not be disturbed.
- The keys of the room must be handed over to Bhavan Master/RATO while going on leave.
- Vehicles are not allowed inside the campus.
- Stickers and Drawing on the walls/cupboards is not allowed.
- Ordering food from outside through Uber/Swiggy/Zomato or parcel from hotel/restaurants is strictly prohibited.
- All the Boarders are expected to pay the fee in time.
- Boarders are not allowed to take anything from the hostel or mess without the permission of the Bhavan Master/RATO.
- Boots/Sport shoes should be used only for the intended purpose.
- Boarders harming, abusing or harassing others will be strictly dealt with.
- Boarders are expected to exhibit an acceptable form of behavior and maintain discipline and decorum at all times.
- Boarders should not indulge in any activity that would result in damaging of the reputation of the college.
- Boarders should follow all the social distancing and hygiene norms laid down by the Government, University/ Board and College.

Violation of hostel rules will not be tolerated and may lead to disciplinary action or even expulsion from the hostel.
