Annual Report of Senior College, 2018-19

I-Term

A) Student strength of senior college for the academic year 2018-19 is 1722 comprising of 943 males and 779 female students.

B) **Academic activities of senior college:-**The Sr. College reopened on 15th June 2018. On-line Admission process was carried out for the students in various Under Graduate and Post-Graduate courses. Academic classes began on 1st July for FY and SY classes. The internal examination of FY, SY, and TY B. Sc. was conducted from 25th September to 29th September 2018 and for Arts and Commerce faculties the exams were conducted from 15th October 2018. The SPPU examination began on 4th Oct. 2018. The first term concluded on 3rd Nov. 2018. Diwali vacation was held from 4th Nov. to 28th Nov. 2018

C) The reaccreditation process (IIIrd Cycle) revisit by NAAC Peer team members was held on 10th and 11th August 2018. The college was awarded "A" Grade (3.05) by NAAC, Bengaluru.
